26	France	Gevrey-Chambertin, Paul Deloux	C	2008/9	13.0	£36.00			Gevrey-Chambertin is one of the great wines of Burgundy and this particular one is matured for up to 14 months in oak barrels before bottling, to further enhance the quality.
